In her previous role at the Ministry of Health of Viet Nam, Dr. Tran chaired the ASEAN senior officials' meetings to develop strategies and action plans for health development among ASEAN countries. She also served as the alternate member of the Executive Board of the World Health Organization, from 2016 – 2019.
